Fatai is the Medical Director at Evergreen Health, where he has worked for over 20 years to insure that all patients, regardless of their race, religion, gender identity, sexual orientation, or condition receive the care and health services they need and deserve. A modest man and truly gifted physician, Fatai specializes in treating the patient, not the disease. However, he respects each patients' right to be who they are, and is revered for his kind and generous nature towards all. When treating his impoverished patients, he provides them services that can lift them out of poverty.

A doctor who was treating patients at the height of the AIDS epidemic, he remembers losing patients he simply could not treat, a crisis that changed him forever. He provided true care when others would or could not, and he feels it made him both a better doctor and a better man.

Fatai is committed to improving both the care and outcomes for his patients. He is a member of the Academy of HIV Medicine, the American College of Physicians, and the NYS AIDS Institute Quality Advisory Committee. He has contributed research and findings to the NYS Aids Institute and the Ryan White Title II program, and he is a role model for those who would provide care to the marginalized populations. He is also a leader in healthcare for the transgendered community.
