A woman of strong faith, much of her volunteerism has been in support of the Catholic Church and its outreach to those in need. She is past Chair of the Board of Trustees for Christ the King Seminary and was a trustee for the Foundation of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Buffalo. She served in the Peaceprints Prison Ministries and the Camp Fire Girls of Buffalo & Erie County. Passionate about equality, she was on the Board of the Center for Women in Management, the Buffalo Branch of the American Association of University Women, the Zonta Club of Buffalo, the Bison Fund, and the Twentieth Century Club. She was the first female president of the Niagara Frontier Chapter of the Public Relations Society of America, and she was inducted into the hall of fame of the SUNY Council for University Affairs and Development.
