He has helped launch several successful initiatives in support of health and wellness, and the inclusion of Native American cultural teachings and activities. Among his many involvements are his work in such coalitions as the “Gathering of Good Minds” and the Regional Multi-Cultural Advisory Committee. He also serves on the Trauma-Informed Coalition of Erie County, AIDS Network of Western New York, and End the Epidemic Coalition of Western New York. In addition, Pete is also a respected official in the regional Lacrosse community.
